Brady Bill. As a result of this suit, the United States Supreme Court ruled the bill unconstitutional and that the *Federal Government could not commandeer state or county officers*. Since then, Sheriff Mack has made it his mission to educate County Sheriffs, law enforcement

officers, and the American citizens about the meaning of being a Constitutional Law Enforcement Officer. Currently he heads up the national office of Constitutional Sheriffs and Peace Officers Associations (CSPOA).
